

# Dogwood Lace Table Runner by Emily Jones



WEAVE STRUCTURE: Atwater-Bronson Lace

WARP/WEFT YARNS: UKI 10/2 Cotton from Yarn Barn in Mint Green.

Wind a warp of 392 threads, 4 yards long (includes a doubled floating selvedge at each side).

SETT: 24 ends per inch, sleyed 2/dent in a 12 dent reed

DIMENSIONS: 15 inches in the reed, 65 inches in length. After wet finishing by hand washing width was 14.5 inches in width x 62 inches in length.

FINISHING: On the loom, ladder hemstitching using 5 thread bundles followed by 2 inches of plain weave at the beginning and end. After the wet finishing, I folded the beginning 4¼ inch plain weave and hand stitched a 2 inch hem on both ends meeting at the ladder hemstitching.

The runner begins with 4¼ inches of plain weave followed by ladder hemstitching using 5 thread bundles at beginning and end. The order of the design is then 4 rows of lace weaving, Flower A, 4 rows of lace weaving, Flower B, 4 rows of lace weaving until you have reached the desired length of the runner. Plain weave borders surround the dogwood flowers in the center of the runner.
