



I have 537 ends + 2 floating selvages for a total of 539 warp ends or 22.46 inches on the loom. The outside twill border is 32 ends or about 1 1/3 inches. The center twill block repeat is 79 ends or 3.29 inches or about 1.5 inches for each square. Sampling would show if the draw-in and shrinkage would bring this close enough to the desired finished size. If the finished size was not satisfactory I could trim out a few ends on the edges.

If this was not your desired size you could remove twill thread repeats from the center blocks or from the motifs or from the edges. You only need to remember to remove the same amount from each block, motif or edge. Other design changes you could consider include adding another, perhaps different, threading motif in the very center or including color blocks, making checks or stripes and using up some of those partial yarn cones in the stash!
