As if all this weren't enough, the last chapter is titled, "Even More With Crackle" which looks at turning designs and provides an in-depth explanation of Zielinski's way to double the apparent number of crackle blocks on a given number of shafts.

The glossary, bibliography and index (notably missing in some weaving books) are exemplary and reflect Susan's precision and logical approach to knowledge. Wilson writes very well and her discussion and directions are clear and concise. Both Susan and Schiffer are to be congratulated for the excellent quality of drafts, photographs and other illustrations. This book "raises the bar" for weaving publications.
